Saturday Walks

A: 24 miles. Linear route from Tealby along the Viking Way, via Roman town of Caistor and Brigg. Coach leaves at 7.45am. Walk starts at 8.30am.

B: 18 miles. Industrial Heritage Walk. Circular walk from the hotel, through woodland, then via Ancolme Valley and back to the hotel. Start at 9am.
